## SUBMISSION OF ABSTRACTS

The **20th National No-Tillage System Meeting** and the **3rd World No-Tillage System Meeting** (20th ENSPD & 3rd EMSPD) aim to bring together academic and scientific communities with agricultural production around a timely and relevant theme:

### **NO-TILLAGE SYSTEM: A FOUNDATION FOR REGENERATIVE AGRICULTURE**

#### **SUBMISSION MODALITIES**

Two distinct modalities will be adopted for the submission and presentation of papers:

##### **1. Technical and/or scientific abstracts**

Papers of a technical and/or scientific nature that present effects or results, even if preliminary, from tests, evaluations or trials of any kind, adopting an appropriate experimental design and methodology consistent with the work developed. The following themes are suggested, aligned with the event programme, but submissions are not limited to these topics:

- Integration of soil chemical, physical and biological properties within the No-Tillage System.
- Strategies for economic diversification and crop rotation in the No-Tillage System.
- Challenges and opportunities for the No-Tillage System in new agricultural frontiers.
- Biological management in the No-Tillage System.
- No-Tillage System and food security.

##### **2. Open-Format Contributions (Free Texts)**

Open-format texts such as testimonials, narratives and historical records, which may be developed within the following suggested lines:

- Historical accounts related to the No-Tillage System.
- Events, lived experiences and case studies involving the No-Tillage System.

- Critical analyses or opinions related to the No-Tillage System.
- Testimonials from young people about the No-Tillage System (in its various dimensions and possibilities, including children of farmers and agricultural workers, students, among others).
- Testimonials from women about the No-Tillage System (in its various dimensions and possibilities, including farmers, producers, agricultural workers, daughters of farmers and students, among others).

## OBJECTIVES OF ABSTRACT SUBMISSION

- To broaden the scope of this debate.
- To highlight the importance of technical studies and scientific research in this field, providing a solid basis for discussion and supporting the development of parameters suited to local realities within the No-Tillage System.
- To guide and encourage the development of new scientific projects in this area.
- To promote interaction between the production chain and academia, valuing quality criteria in the adoption of the No-Tillage System by farmers and encouraging academia to continue and expand research aimed at generating internationally accepted indicators that demonstrate the benefits of the No-Tillage System.
- To identify potential challenges in the evolution of the No-Tillage System and address them in a technical and impartial manner.
- To encourage the participation of young scientists, academics, professionals and farmers in this forum for debate, valuing their contributions.
- To expand female participation across all sectors.

**We invite the academic, technical and productive communities to join this initiative. While the decision to participate is individual, the impacts and benefits will always be collective.**

## Poster Session for Technical and/or Scientific Abstracts

Approved abstracts will be presented as posters in a designated area of the event. Authors are required to be present at the poster area during the times indicated in the event programme. Posters will be evaluated, and all approved abstracts will be published in the **Proceedings of the 20th ENSPD & 3rd EMSPD**, which will be available for download on the event website after the event. Authors are advised to carefully read the guidelines below and to follow the submission procedure and the poster template provided.

## Sharing Circle and Open Discussion for Open-Format Texts

For abstracts approved under this modality, a **sharing circle and open discussion** will be held among authors and the interested audience, fostering in-depth discussion and exchange of experiences. The first selection stage will be based on the scores assigned by the Evaluation Committee. The second stage will take place through a public vote on the first day of the event, selecting three works to be presented and discussed. This session is scheduled in the programme for the end of the second day of the event, and authors are required to be present at the designated location and time. Abstracts submitted under this modality will have a specific section in the event proceedings. Authors selected in the first stage will be notified **14 days prior to the event**. Only authors who confirm payment of the registration fee and attendance at the event will be eligible to participate in the second selection stage.

## GENERAL INFORMATION

The deadline for abstract submission is **April 15, 2026**.

1. Submitted abstracts must be in plain text, with a maximum of **350 words for technical and/or scientific abstracts** and a maximum of **1,000 words** for open-format texts, such as testimonials, reports and historical records. Submissions will be accepted in **Portuguese, Spanish and English**.
2. Papers will be presented as **posters** for the technical and/or scientific modality and as a **discussion circle** for the open-format text modality.

3. To submit an abstract, at least one of the authors must complete the event registration. The abstract submission process is carried out in the participant's area.
4. Participants are encouraged to submit abstracts as **members of FEBRAPDP** in order to obtain a discount on the event registration fee and to benefit from the prerogatives granted to members throughout the year. More information is available at: <https://febrapdp.org.br/associe-se>.
5. Payment of the registration fee by the author responsible for the submission must be completed **no later than June 7**, in order for the abstract to be included in the event proceedings and scheduled for poster presentation or participation in the discussion circle.
6. A maximum of **two abstracts per registered author** will be accepted.
7. Abstracts will be evaluated by the **Evaluation Committees** corresponding to each submission modality.
8. The list of accepted abstracts will be published on the event website by **May 30**.
9. The **content** and **formatting** of the abstract submitted in the system are the sole **responsibility of the author**.
10. Abstracts will **not** be returned for revision.
11. The **Proceedings of the 20th ENSPD & 3rd EMSPD**, containing abstracts and open-format texts, will be published and made available in digital format on the event website after the event.

## GUIDELINES AND INSTRUCTIONS FOR ABSTRACT PREPARATION AND SUBMISSION

Abstracts must be submitted in **Portuguese, Spanish or English**, with all content entered directly into the submission system:

1. Select the abstract modality: **technical and/or scientific papers** or **open-format texts**.
2. Enter the **title** (in **uppercase letters**).
3. Enter **five keywords**, separated by a semicolon (;).

4. Indicate the **funding agency**, if applicable.
5. Copy and paste the abstract text. A maximum of **350 words is allowed for technical and/or scientific abstracts**, and a maximum of **1,000 words for open-format texts**, such as testimonials, reports and historical records. **ATTENTION:** the system will not accept texts that exceed the character limit for each category. Carefully check the formatting of words, special characters and measurement units.
6. Complete the list of **authors**, including the author's name, **institution** (without address) and **e-mail**. If an author is affiliated with more than one institution, include the abbreviated names of the institutions, separated by a semicolon (;).
7. Careful proofreading and proper presentation of abstracts are strongly recommended, as they will be reproduced in the proceedings exactly as submitted, without technical or grammatical revision, and are therefore the sole responsibility of the author. Abstract evaluation by the Evaluation Committee will consist of assigning a score and confirming the relevance of the submission to the event theme.

## POSTER PREPARATION GUIDELINES

After abstract evaluation and **APPROVAL**, authors must prepare their **POSTER**.

Posters will be displayed in a designated area at the event venue and will remain available for viewing throughout the entire event. However, posters will only be displayed and abstracts published in the event proceedings upon confirmation of **registration fee payment by the submitting author by June 7**.

### Guidelines

The **POSTER** must be prepared and presented according to the **POSTER TEMPLATE**, following the guidelines below:

1. The poster must be prepared in the same language as the submitted abstract and must measure **1.20 m (height) × 0.90 m (width)**.
2. Poster text and visual elements (figures, photographs, tables and graphs) must be clearly legible, allowing proper reading from a minimum distance of **2 meters**.

3. The following information must be clearly displayed on the poster: **title, authors' names, institution, city/state/country, contact information and funding source**, if applicable. The structure and subdivision of content are at the authors' discretion, allowing for different forms of presentation.
4. The poster title must be identical to the title of the abstract submitted and/or approved by the Evaluation Committee.
5. Posters that do not comply with the general standards of legibility and formatting will **not** be accepted for presentation.
6. Poster mounting and removal are the sole responsibility of the author.
7. Posters may only be mounted in the area designated by the event organization and will remain on display throughout the event.
8. The official presentation, with the mandatory presence of at least **one of the authors**, will take place during the time slot specified in the programme.
9. Authors are fully responsible for the content and materials displayed on their posters.

**IMPORTANT!** All content presented in abstracts and posters is the sole responsibility of the authors and does not necessarily reflect the views or opinions of the Board of the **Brazilian Federation of No-Tillage System (FEBRAPDP)**.

## AWARDS

Submitted works will compete for an award and may receive a **Certificate of Honorable Mention**. **Three works will be selected for each submission modality** based on the scores assigned by the Evaluation Committee. In the case of the open-format text modality, the selection will also include a public vote. Additional information regarding the awards will be made available in due course.
